Duplication Approval

Regarding rights for mechanical duplication, copy rights, author's rights, other rights

Principal has ordered contractor to produce mechanical duplicates by a pressing plant (mechanical duplicator).

This duplication approval is effective for the present but also for all prospective agreements and production orders made between principal and contractor even if it is not referred to in every case and attached to every production order. The duplication approval is also effective with retroactive effect to the date of the first production order. It is also effective if titles are not listed separately as both contracting parties agree to only accept orders for which principal makes a copy right declaration.

Principal declares to own full rights for duplicating, e.g. the right for duplicating mechanically, the right to use defined film, sound and other recordings and warrants that all costs for copy right releases are paid to the respective authority and that the pressing plant (mechanical duplicator) is not liable for these matters.

Principal and contractor agree bindingly in a contract for the benefit of a third party corresponding to § 328 BGB and for the benefit of the pressing plant (mechanical duplicator) that principal compensates the pressing plant regarding these rights and especially for all claims of third parties including claims of copy right authorities or respective organizations as well as possible costs for legal and court fees that can incur with a claimed or actual violation of these rights.
